KEY INSIGHT 1: Republicans and Independents in swing districts want conservative populist policy without the insurgent, uncompromising rhetoric.

Most Persuasive Conservative Messages to Republicans and Independents

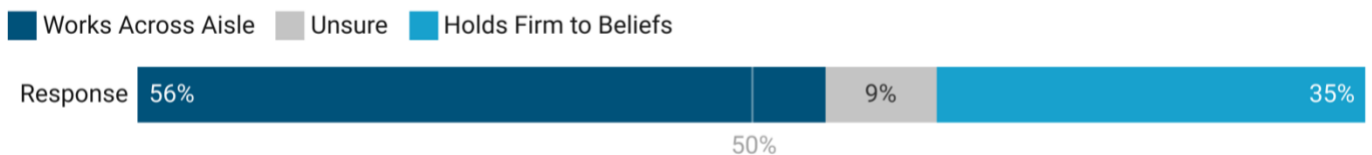
Message	More Likely
If you knew Congressional Republicans have led the charge against the Chinese Communist Party, holding them accountable for unfair trade practices, illegal cyberattacks, lying about COVID-19, and demanding justice for imprisoned religious minorities and pro-democracy activists, would that make you more or less likely to vote for a Republican for Congress?	74%
If you knew Congressional Republicans have strongly and consistently supported efforts to secure our southern border and are best equipped to find solutions to end the crisis of unaccompanied minors crossing the border, would that make you more or less likely to vote for a Republican for Congress?	68%
If you knew Congressional Republicans were fighting to stop President Joe Biden's gun control actions that would limit your second amendment right to bear arms, would that make you more or less likely to vote for a Republican for Congress?	66%

Someone that will uphold the institutions of government, or an insurgent that will shake up the status quo?

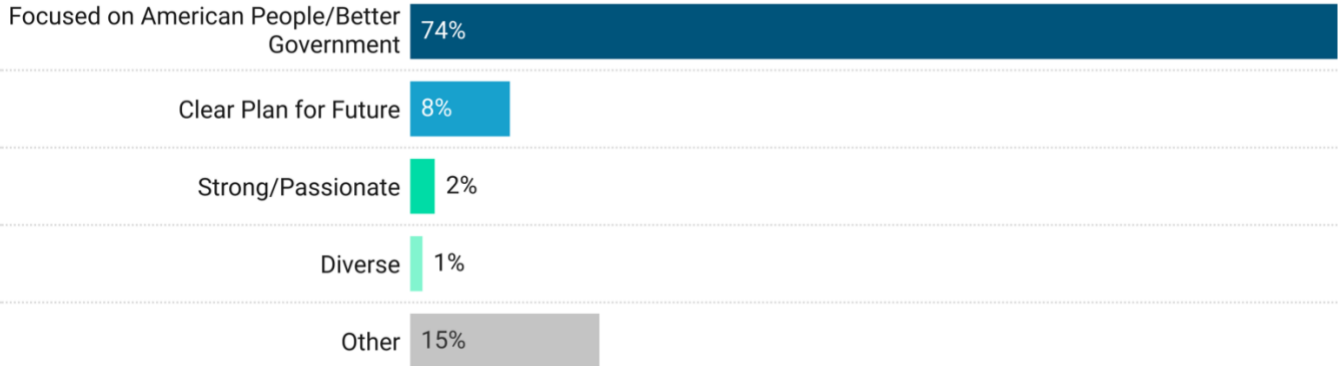


Someone who works across the aisle to get legislation passed, or someone who holds firm to their beliefs regardless of circumstances to compromise on policy?

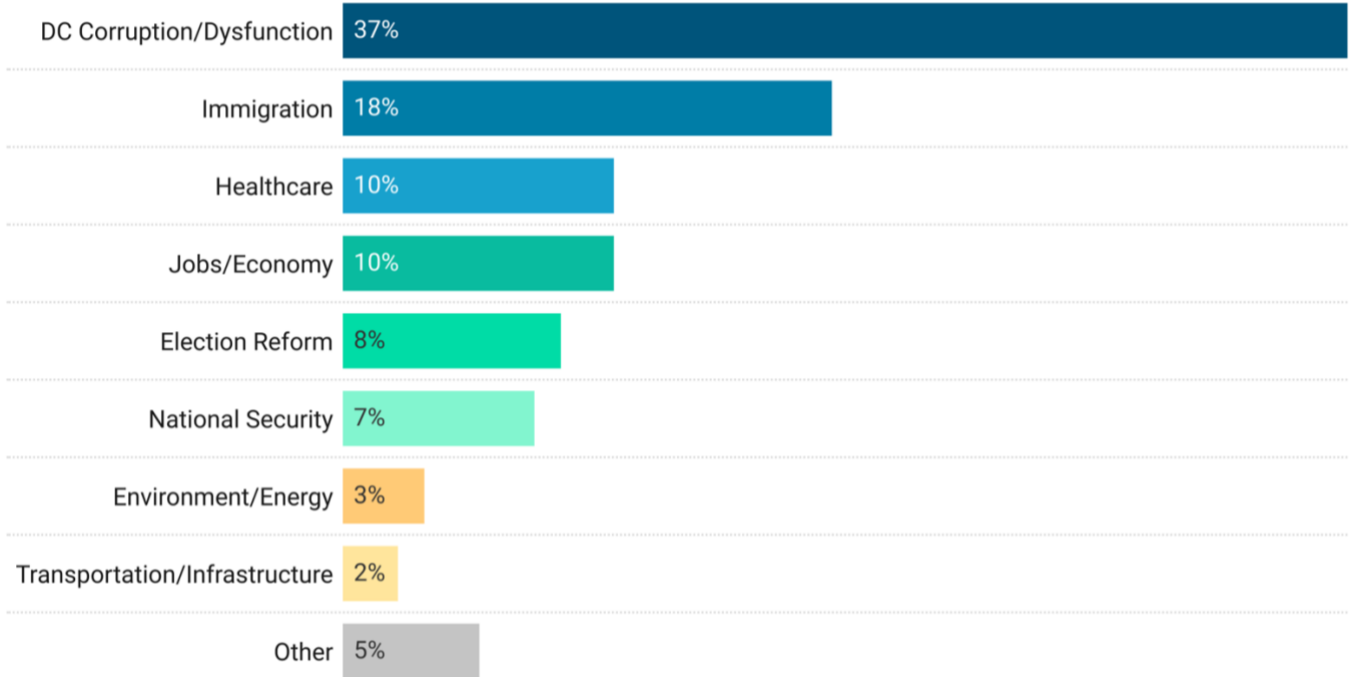

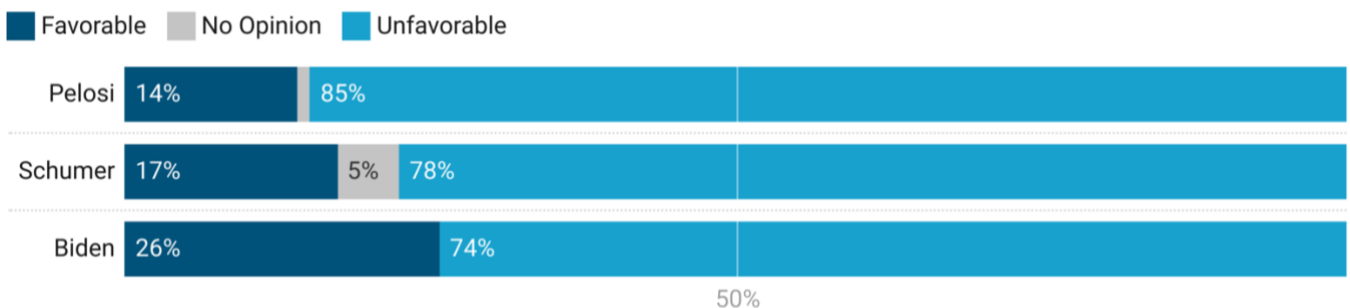
What trait or value do you find most appealing in a candidate for Congress?

Methodology:

Republican Main Street Partnership conducted a survey of 599 registered voters that self-identified as Republicans and Independents in six key 2022 battleground House districts: GA-6, KS-3, MO-2, MO-3, NC-9, PA-1. Responses were collected April 13-22, 2021 online and via text to web. The results were carefully weighted on age, education, ethnicity, gender, and geography, with a margin of error of $\pm 6.3\%$.
